Quote:

Luk 17:33 Whoever shall seek to save his self (psyche) shall lose it, and (psyche) shall preserve it.

Implying if you remove all forms of self, then you aim to be Godly; which questioning self. The way it was originally put using the word life, implying you'll be saved, which is completely wrong.

Quote:

Luk 14:26 If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own self (psyche) also, he cannot be My disciple. This verse is commonly misunderstood, due to not perceiving the overall statement:

Quote:

Luk 16:13 No servant can serve two masters. For either he will hate the one and love the other, else he will hold to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and worship (worship).

In other words, when you love God with your entire mind, heart, strength, things are open to you and the energy of the universe flows through you. more than God, that is a form of idolatry.

Quote:

Luk 12:22-23 And He said to His disciples, Therefore I say to you, Be not anxious for the body, what you shall eat; nor for the body, what you shall put on. (23 food, and the body is more than clothing.
