Deuteronomy 32:15-18 But Jeshurun grew fat, and kicked. You have grown thick. You have become sleek. Then he abandoned their Divine Being (H433), rejected the Rock of his salvation. (H3444) (16) They moved him to jealousy. They provoked him to anger with abominations. (17) They sacrificed to deities (H433), to Divine Beings (H430) that they didn't know, to new 'ideals' which your fathers didn't dread. (18) Of the Rock who became your father, they have forgotten God (H410) 'who manifests you'.
Thus basically they've rejected Yeshua who was the Right Arm of the Lord, to follow Ha-Shamash, which was a legalistic deity of the Babylonians, which was found in Leviticus, which was correlated in Babylon.

When Jews & Christendom believe that Yahavah Elohim is God, that is hence the Divine Council; Islam was correct when it says we should only worship the One (El Elyon) - Not beings which are made by the Source of reality.
