

Title: Communion

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Summary: The idea of communion has been passed down by the Pharisees. They believe that Christ told people to do it, as it would break the law of Moses.

Now to many this will shock you, Paul established communion with wine and bread that say we must drink the blood of Christ. Many of the Christian ideologies are based around this. When we look at what the bible said about drinking and what it meant to see why this is wrong.

Quote:

Mat 26:29 But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom.

This is the way it is translated, as from what John and Paul had said this would mean. Yet within the context of the bible this would make Yeshua a deceiver, as he was talking about drinking and especially eating or drinking blood.

This is what it says in Greek, with a very rough translation taken from the original text. Quote:

Mat 26:29 I ask of you that you don't drink of, from the fruit of the vine, until the day I drink with you, new in the kingdom of the father of mine.

So with odd bits added by me, to make it make more sense in the translation, it comes out as:

I ask of you that you don't drink of, from the fruit of the vine, until the day I drink with you, new in the kingdom of the father of mine.

This could be done in any of the books Matthew, Mark and Luke and it could be done in any of the other books of the bible.

saying not to drink, as he had said earlier, and the bible clearly states.
Quote:

Mat 10:42 and whoever shall give to one of these little ones a cup of cold water in the name of a disciple, truly I say to you, He shall in no way lose his reward.

So what else confirms this that we are not to drink of the vine, as if it is water?
Quote:

Rev 16:6 since they have poured out the blood of the saints and prophets, they shall drink, for they were deserving.

If we check what this means within the context of the bible.
Quote:

Gen 9:4 but you shall not eat of flesh with the life in it, or the blood of it.

Lev 3:17 It shall be a statute forever for your generations throughout all your land, neither fat nor blood.

Lev 7:26-27 and you shall not eat any blood, of fowl or of beast, in any of your land, for the soul who eats any blood, even that soul shall be cut off from his people.

Lev 17:10-14 And any man of the house of Israel, or of the strangers that dwell among you, who eats any blood, I will set My face against that soul who eats blood, among his people. (11) For the life of the flesh is in the blood. (14) For it is the life of all flesh. Its blood shall not be eaten. I have said to the sons of Israel, You shall not eat the blood of any flesh. For the life of the flesh is in the blood, and I have said to you, that you shall not eat the blood, for it is the life. Whoever eats it shall be cut off.

Deut 12:23 only be sure that you do not eat the blood. For the blood is the life of the flesh, and the life is with the flesh.

Now if Christ told us that we should keep the laws of Moses, how can we say that either Christ was daft which I seriously doubt, or John made up a lot of voodoo? Yet as it is written:

Quote:

Isaiah 66:4 I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them, because they called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did even despise my voice, they chose that in which I delighted not.

Psalm 16:4 their sorrows shall be multiplied who run after another god. I will not take their offerings of blood; and I will not take their names on my lips.

This is almost prophecy of what occurred later, yet not set out by Christ, John and Paul. How come they could have been so convinced of something self, is beyond me. Yet this then fulfills the rest of the prophecies concerning
Quote:

Rev 17:6 And I saw the woman drunk with the blood of the saints and with the blood of) Yeshua. And when I saw her, I marveled with a great marveling.

In the Greek it doesn't include "of" so therefore it may mean the blood of the saints in a logical sense, as Babylon has spread that we drink the blood as a ritual.
Quote:

Hab 2:12 Woe to him who builds a town with blood, and establishes a city with blood.

So what were the disciples doing after his death to remember him by?
Quote:

Act 2:46 and continuing with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from day to day, they shared food with gladness and simplicity of heart,

Act 20:7 and on the first of the Sabbaths, the disciples having been assembled together about to depart on the morrow, Paul reasoned to them. And he continued saying unto them,

So logical as Christ had shown, they broke bread the same as it had been shown by Christ had shown through out his ministry by sharing bread among the multitude. It is stated as this break the Law of Moses as we are told not to drink blood.
