

Title: Christ Taught Reincarnation

Heb 9:27 and as it is appointed to men once to die, but after this the judgment

This in some ways correct as when you die, you will be judged for the actions you do around the world. Many people have experiences of reincarnation, some people have memories of past life's including Christians, I have met. There are children born with talents and families, and past items that were theirs in a past life, knowing all details of their past lives. Things that only they would have known, if they were, the reincarnation of Buddha's are rigorously tested to check, that they are the reincarnation of the person. They will have to point out, from hundreds of items and identify what was theirs in their past life as the same spirit.

Now as a follower of Yeshua is this correct, you may ask? Well what did Yeshua say?

Mat 11:13-14 for all the Prophets and the Law prophesied until John. (11) And this is Elijah who is to come.

Mat 17:10-13 and His disciples asked Him, saying, why then do the scribes say that Elijah come first? (11) And answering Yeshua said to them, Elijah truly shall come first. (12) But I say to you that Elijah has come already, and they did not believe in him to him whatever they desired. Likewise also the Son of Man shall suffer many things. His disciples understood that He spoke to them about John the Baptist.

Mar 9:12-13 and he answered and told them, Elijah truly does come first. It has been written of the Son of Man that He should suffer many things. But I say to you that Elijah has indeed come, and they have done to him what was written of him.

This is very clear that Yeshua said that reincarnation can happen, as Elijah said.

So to say that John was Elijah must mean that reincarnation from the beginning of John's life, so if Yeshua said he was Elijah then that is not that they are the same person in mind exactly as they lead different lives. Within the western world get it a bit muddled up, as you see we are taught from a young age. What occurs is the spirit is not the body; the spirit is what makes someone who they will be. Quote:

Mar 8:27-30 And Yeshua and His disciples went out into the towns of Caesarea Philippi. On the way He asked His disciples, saying to them, who do men say that I am? They said, John the Baptist. But others say Elijah, and others say one of the prophets. He said to them, but who do you say that I am? And Peter answered and said to Him, You are the Christ. And He charged them that they should tell no one of Him.

This shows that as well as what Yeshua said, at that time people must have believed that they can be reborn in another body. Else why would the people believe that Yeshua was the Christ, partially believe in reincarnation, as in Jerusalem they are waiting for Elijah to come, things, so that they may begin to build the temple.
Quote:

Mal 4:5-6 Behold, I am sending you Elijah the prophet before the coming of the day of Jehovah. (6) And he shall turn the heart of the fathers to the sons, and the hearts of the sons to their fathers, that I not come and strike the earth with utter destruction.

Now within all I am saying, Elijah may still come again and may be already here. Infinite and the prophecy concerning Elijah has still to be fully finished. Now an angel from God appeared to Zacharias, the father of John the Baptist.
Quote:

Luk 1:17 And he shall go before Him in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the fathers to the children, and the disobedient to the wisdom of the just, to make ready the Lord.

So later when the priests came and asked John is he Elijah, either John had been told by God's angel, which would be seriously doubtful. As you would expect his father would be, to tell his son something like this.
Quote:

Joh 1:21 and they asked him, what then? Are you Elijah? And he says, I am not. Are you the prophet? And he answered, no.

Else again as in other parts in the book of John this is made up, to cover up the fact that both John the Baptist and Yeshua were the same person. Also even if he was Elijah in spirit, in flesh he led his own life. Elijah lived in a different time period and experience was the same. Quote:

Mat 3:4 and the same John had his clothing of camel's hair and a leather sash, and his food was locusts and wild honey.

2Ki 1:8 and they answered him; He was a hairy man and was bound with a sash around his loins. And he said, He is Elijah the Tishbite.

So with in all of this you can see, what has been taught by Paul and his disciples, which Yeshua originally taught.
