Matthew - Tax collector - Disciple of Yeshua

27:3-8 Then he who had betrayed Him, seeing that He was condemned, so the thirty pieces of silver again to the chief priests and elders, (4) saying innocent blood. And they said, what is that to us? You see to that. (5) And he threw the silver down in the temple and departed. And he went and hanged himself. Mat 23:13-35 But woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you shut up the Kingdom of Heaven against men. For you neither go in, nor do you allow those entering. Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you devour widows' houses, and you make long pretence. Therefore you shall receive the greater condemnation. (15) Woe to you, Pharisees, hypocrites! For you compass sea and the dry land to make one mite (and all over making Pharisees) and when he is made, you make him twofold more unprofitable to yourselves. (16) Woe to you, blind guides, saying, Whoever shall swear by the temple, he is a debtor; but whoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor. (17) And I say unto you, the greater, the gold, or the temple that sanctifies the gold? (18) And, Who swears by the temple, it is nothing; but whoever swears by the Sacrifice that is on it, he is guilty. (19) For you swear he is your sacrifice as you have been told to, then you have judged him and not with him) (19) Fools and blind! For which is greater, the sacrifice that sanctifies the sacrifice? (20) Therefore whoever shall swear by the altar things on it. (21) And whoever shall swear by the temple, swears by it. (22) And he who shall swear by Heaven swears by the throne of God, and by Him who sits there. (23) Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint, anise, and cummin, and you have left undone the weightier matters of the Law, judgment, mercy, and faith. (24) Blind guides who do not see, you shall swallow a camel! (25) Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you tithe of the cup and of the dish, but inside they are full of extortion and excess. (26) Cleanse the inside of the cup and of the dish, so that the outside of them may also be clean. (27) Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewash. (28) For you appear beautiful outside, but inside they are full of dead men's bones, and all manner of uncleanness. (29) Even so you also appear righteous to men outwardly, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and iniquity. (30) Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you build the tombs of the prophets, and decorate the tombs of the righteous, (31) and say, We would not have been partakers with them in the building of these tombs. (32) Therefore you are witnesses to yourselves, that you are the sons of those who build the tombs of the prophets, and you fill up the measure of your fathers. (33) Serpents! Offspring of vipers! How can you escape the condemnation of hell? (34) therefore, behold, I send prophets and wise men and scribes to you. And you will kill and crucify some of them. And some of them you

synagogues and persecute from city to city; (35) so that on you may come shed on the earth, from the blood of righteous Abel to the blood of Zechariah whom you killed between the temple and the altar. (so by claiming Christ measure, so all who do this, God is your judge, why there will be gnashing of teeth.)

Mark - Real name, John Mark, fisher man - Disciple of Yeshua
12:1-9 And He began to speak to them by parables. A man planted a vineyard, and he let it out to vinedressers, and he went on a journey. In the season he sent a servant to the vinedressers, so that he might receive fruit of the vineyard. (3) And taking him, they beat him and sent him away. And he sent to them another servant. And stoning that one, they struck him in the head, insulting him. (5) And again he sent another. And they killed him, and stoned and killing some. (the prophets) (6) Therefore, still having one son, his beloved, he sent him to them last of all, saying, they will respect my son. (7) But those vinedressers themselves, this is the heir! Come, let us kill him and the inheritance shall be ours. (the Anti-Christ's, Paul, John and Simon) (8) And they took him and killed him. (9) Therefore what will the lord of the vineyard do? He will come and will give the vineyard to others. (This means the Jews have been seen, they lost their nation after this, next is all who claim Christ died for inheritance)
