Subtitle: What is the Parable of the Fig

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In all three Synoptic Gospels Yeshua warns to watch for the Parable of the Fig. Mark 13:28-31, Luke 21:29-33.

These reference Isaiah 28:4 where there are the same keywords used by Yeshua: "Forth, know the summer is near".

The names Yehoshua, and Yeshayahu are a reverse of each other Lord Saiahu, Lord Saiahu.

In Isaiah 28:11-13 it warns of the 2nd coming, the 1st being in Isaiah 8:14 'Snare among the disciples', with Simon being a 'Stone of Stumbling'; while the Synoptic Gospels are as a 'Rock of offence', to those who understand.

Isaiah 28:9-19 is a 'Bed of Adultery' with the 'Chief Corner Stone placed in Isaiah 28:20-21, it tells us it is a 'Bed of Adultery' in Hebrew.

Isaiah 28:22 warns 'not to be mockers of these things', as this is to establish mankind, like in the past to remove 'the many ravenous beings'.
