Subtitle: Who is the Dajjal?

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The Al-Masih ad-Dajjal is a false representation of Yeshua the Messiah.

People think the Dajjal is to come as a person, who will claim to be the Messiah. If they read the religious texts, they'd realize the descriptions of the false representation have already happened.

The Quran was warning that the texts had become corrupted, and that the Messiah was still to come in the world; yet later Hadiths have given the impression it is still to come.

Yeshua was a man of coloured skin; he wasn't white.

His full name was Yehoshua, which means the 'Lord Saves' or he 'Shall bring salvation'... Yeshua means Salvation.

Yeshua didn't teach we have to believe in his death for atonement; he taught forgiveness of sin. It was the Pharisees and Sadducees who made the stumbling stone (petros) that taught we are to believe in his death & resurrection.

Yeshua didn't teach people to worship him; yet corrected them, and told them to worship the Most High (Mark 11:21-22). The God Most High in Hebrew is El Elyon, and the Most High is the Source of reality to interact with Creation; the Word or Code created by God. The Messiah isn't God incarnate; yet it is through the Divine Council (38:69, 37:8).

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Yeshua was indicating it is better not to drink alcohol, and eat meat - which the Church didn't; then Pauline Christianity rewrote the concepts into Pharisee. This is a start to some of the contradictions between what Yeshua put forward and the Hellenized Christian Church corrupted.
