(5) They cried to You, and were not in You, and were not ashamed. (6) But I am a worm, and no man; a reproach by the people. (7) All who see Me mock me; they shoot out the lip; they deride Me. He trusted on Jehovah; let Him deliver Him; let Him rescue Him, since He has said, You are He who took Me out of the womb, causing Me to trust while on My mother. You were cast on You from the womb; You are My God from My mother's belly. My trouble is near, for there is none to help. (12) Many bulls have circled Me; Bashan have surrounded Me. (13) They opened wide their mouths on Me like a roaring lion. (14) I am poured out like water, and all My bones are spread like wax; it is melted in the midst of My bowels. (15) My strength is dried up, and my tongue clings to My jaws; (16) and You have brought Me into the dust of death. (19) But You, O Jehovah, be not far from Me; help Me! (20) Deliver My soul from the sword, My only one from the dog's mouth; from the lion's mouth; from the wild oxen's horns. You have answered Me, O Jehovah, by the name of Your name to My brothers; in the midst of the congregation I will praise You. All the nations shall praise Him; all of you, the seed of Jacob, glorify Him; and fear Him all the earth. He has not despised nor hated the affliction of the afflicted; and He has heard but when he cried to Him, He heard. (25) My praise shall be of You in the temple; pay My vows before the ones who fear Him. (26) The meek shall eat and drink and seek Jehovah shall praise Him; your heart shall live forever.
