@Kameron Waters - When Yeshua is saying that the Kingdom of Heaven is near, he isn't saying here is Heaven, he is saying that the prophecies concerning the world down near Hell have come.

When we do a Bible word search in software like Esword with a KJV+, on (G1448), it has been translated as 'at hand', yet it can mean 'to be near'.
