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Lets expound on what 'The Way' is, as it is a fascinating global concept; limitation.

Shinto means 'Way of the Gods', the Tao means 'The Way', Islamic Shari Buddhist Noble Eightfold Path is called 'The Way', Jewish Halakha means

So whereas some might from the bigoted Pharisaic Babylonian Christian wide road that Yeshua warned about, it is actually a very narrow Way, as each of these religious connotations in their own mechanisms to see that

Biblically this modern usage of calling the Ebionites 'Followers of the Way' from Paul's attack on them, and so the Book of Acts is not correctly identifying Jewish movement; it seems mainly so they could use Acts to sell Christianity to the Gentiles (Acts 9:2, 19:9+23, 22:4, 24:14+22).

When we look at the Abrahamic systems language, both have this same sense. Jewish Halakha means in keeping to the moral Laws, is to keep to 'The Way'. the Islamic Sharia - it becomes clear that this keeping to a moral code is keeping to 'The Way'.

The Dharma means 'to keep to ones Duty' - which is the moral code that Source; within the Dharmic principles ascribed of keeping a Veggie diet, (good action), Bhakti Yoga (practise devotion to the divine), Raja Yoga (etc, these similar principles are the same ascribed by each of the other

Thus what I'm trying to summarize for you all, is that 'The Way' isn't something a devotee of one Avatar; it is a universal principle that comes from God, back to God - which has been a similar concept given to us from all of the
