Overview

Achilles, the greatest warrior of the age, follows the advice of Athena and withdraws from battle in revenge and the allied Achaean (Greek) armies suffer.

In counterpoint to Achilles' pride and arrogance stands the Trojan prince Hector with a wife and child, who fights to defend his city and his family. The death of his dearest friend or lover, at the hands of Hector, brings Achilles back to the battle. He slays Hector. Later Hector's father, King Priam, comes to Achilles alone (with Hermes) to ransom his son's body back, and Achilles is moved to pity; thus ends the poem.
