Note: You cannot use both `ob_gzhandler()` and `zlib.output_compression`. `zlib.output_compression` is preferred over `ob_gzhandler()`.

Also you can find numerous reports of Gzip messing things up or not working.

So within our own site everything uses Zlib, Mysql can use Zlib also, the same so even sites you browse through an Iframe go faster...Plus all data retrieved is being compressed.

That's for a Xoops site, which you will either find in `include/common.php` (2.1), which is sluggish in comparison and has a level set, which may cause problems depending on users....Also in the `class/theme.php` of 2.2, yet was removed properly...(plus not advised to be switched on from there, yet common.php is retrieved through it also, plus the `header.php` for all contents to be compressed).

That is just for normal PHP and on my home server I have just that with Gzip loading slowly.... So then compressing all data retrieved through it and then surfing...
