*Isaiah 54:16 "Behold, I have created the blacksmith who fans the coals with a weapon for his work; and I have created 'our anointed' (the destroyer) to destroy."*

*Jeremiah 2:30 "I have struck your children in vain. They received no comfort. I have devoured your prophets, like 'our anointed' (destroying) lion."*
