Subtitle: The Quran and Bible taught a Divine Council in Ancient

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Religion has become confused from people turning the Archangels who in the Bible are demigods, and creating forms of polytheism, and henotheism.

38:69 I had no knowledge of the Heavenly Beings when they were debating about me (Adam).

37:8 They cannot listen to the higher group (angels) for they are pelted with stones. Part of the problem why many have become confused is the Bible has been corrupted since Babylon, creating a form of henotheism to reject the Babylonian polytheism. Isaiah 46:9 prophesied about the Children of Babylon declaring that El is Lord. Go back at Deuteronomy 32:7-9 saying remember the former theology.

When we look at a Dharmic perspective this makes far more sense, that the Source is Vishnu, and there are 24 Elders surrounding the Source of reality (Brahma). Havah (Hebrew) and Brahma (Sanskrit) mean the same thing (to become, 'Creator'), and have the same root breath. Thus Yah meaning Lord, and Hava is the direct translation of Bhagavan Brahma; where the Babylonian Jews reject the Source in these contexts.

When we understand that the Divine Council are the founders of the religions, it makes more sense that God is the one interacting with us, and mankind has created individual religions, when it is all one theology.
