In Ancient Hebrew the terminology 'Flock' was pronounced Zan (צ which is also [a name of the Creator in many different cultures globally](#)

Like for example the Nicene Church Fathers, understood that Zeus (Zan) from the Roman Pantheon, and Jove from the Hebrew.

Thus when in Revelation 3:12 it says the Messiah will return with the name this is Zion (ציון).

Zion was the place of David, and Zan is the flock; where the Messiah is the Shepherd over our people.

In Revelation when it says the Lamb with 7 eyes was sent out among the people this is referring to the Flock of Israel, and thus the word Lamb in Revelation

When understood this makes the Lamb's Book of Life, Zan's (Zeus's) Book of Life (Revelation 21:27).

There are multiple verses in the Tanakh that refer to Zion being the dwelling place of the Lord of Creation, and that out of Zion it shall physically speak i.e the Messiah is to be born there (Psalms 146:10, Psalms 147:12, Isaiah 52:7).

Here are many verses where Zion becomes the place that the Lord of Creation dwells in:

Quote:

Psalms 132:13-14 Jehovah has chosen Zion; he has desired it for his dwelling place forever; here I will dwell; for I have desired it.

Joel 3:17 So you shall know that I am Jehovah your God (your Divine Being) and I will dwell in the holy mountain. And Jerusalem shall be a holy thing, and no aliens shall dwell there.

Joel 3:21 And I will cleanse their blood which I did not cleanse; and Jehovah will dwell in Jerusalem.

Isaiah 12:6 Cry out and shout, O dweller of Zion; for great is the Holy One in the midst of you.

Isaiah 2:3 And many people shall go and say, Come, and let us go to the the house of the God of Jacob. And he will teach us of His ways, and we out of Zion shall go out the Law, and the Word of Jehovah from Jerusalem.

Micah 4:2 And many nations shall come and say, Come and let us go up to and to the house of the God of Jacob. And He will teach us of His ways, paths; for the Law shall go forth out of Zion, and the Word of Jehovah from

Micah 4:7 And I will make the lame into a remnant, and her who was cast Jehovah shall reign over them in Mount Zion from now on, even forever.

Isaiah 24:23 Then the moon will be disgraced and the sun ashamed; for J in Mount Zion, and in Jerusalem and before his elders, gloriously.

Isaiah 40:9 You who tell good news to Zion, go up on a high mountain. Y Jerusalem, lift up your voice with strength. Lift it up. Don t be afraid. Sa Behold, your God (your Divine Being)!

Isaiah 52:7 How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of him who bring peace heard; who brings good news, making salvation (Yeshua) heard; wh (your Divine Being) reigns!

Psalms 99:2 Jehovah in Zion is great; and He is high above all the people

Amos 1:2 And he said, Jehovah will roar from Zion and utter His voice from pastures of the shepherds shall mourn, and the top of Carmel shall dry up

Joel 3:16 Jehovah shall also roar out of Zion and utter His voice from Jerusalem and the earth shall shake. But Jehovah will be the hope of His people and Israel.

Jeremiah 31:6 For there shall be a day that the watchmen on Mount Ephraim us go up to Zion to Jehovah our God (our Divine Being)!

Isaiah 18:7 In that time shall be brought to Jehovah of Hosts the present smooth people, from it and onward; a mighty and trampling nation whose divided, to the place of the name of Jehovah of Hosts, Mount Zion.
